

Library service to Columbia County residents, both rural and municipal is provided by the libraries in Columbia County with assistance from county funds. These public libraries are in the communities of Wisconsin Dells, Cambria, Columbus, Lodi, Pardeeville, Portage, Poynette, Randolph, Rio, and Wyocena. County funds are essential to assure that our libraries can provide vital services to all of our patrons. The county finance committee is proposing a budget cut in 2023 funding for libraries. **At the budget hearing on November 15,** the 10 county libraries will be requesting that the 2023 Columbia County Library budget be restored to the same funding level that we received in 2022. *Please fill out a postcard in support of your library*. Postcards are available at the library and on the bookmobile. Please let your county representative know that your library is important to you.
