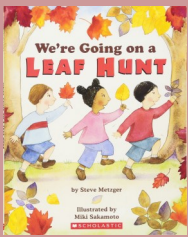




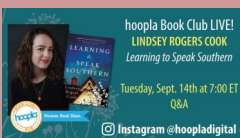




New Story-Walk!
