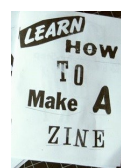

Library Book Club

In keeping with the haunted spirit of October the library book club is reading *A Touch of Dead* by Charlaine Harris. The book is a collection of short stories about Sookie Stackhouse, a telepathic waitress. Some of the stories are totally lighthearted and some are more serious, but they all shine a light on a little facet of Sookie's life and times. Charlaine Harris' novels serve as the basis for the television program, *True Blood*. Pick up a copy of *A Touch of Dead* at the library or the bookmobile. Then join us on **Monday, October 28 at 6:30 p.m. or Wednesday, October 30 at 1:30 p.m.** to discuss Sookie and her world of vampires, werewolves and other supernatural creatures. It promises to be interesting conversation and we'll bring a treat!

And don't forget we will have a special discussion of *The Butterfly Mosque* on **Thursday, October 17 at 7:00 p.m.** Journalist G. Willow Wilson's remarkable story of converting to Islam and falling in love with an Egyptian man in a volatile post-9/11 world, was praised as "an eye-opening look at a misunderstood and often polarizing faith" (*Booklist*) and "tremendously heartfelt, healing" (*Publishers Weekly*).
